

# 2010 NAVIGATION / MULTIMEDIA Receiver Firmware Update Guide

## Introduction

- This document describes the procedure and precautions for upgrading the 2010 NAVIGATION / MULTIMEDIA receiver firmware.
- If an error occurs while you are updating the firmware, the 2010 NAVIGATION / MULTIMEDIA receiver may become unusable.
- Be sure to read the following procedure and precautions carefully before

## Target models

This updater can be used to update the firmware of the following models.

## Target firmware

The unit will be upgraded to the following version by executing this update version: **1.1.0**

If your unit's version is earlier than that of the above, carry out the updating procedure.

For the information on how to check the firmware version, refer to "Checking the Firmware Version" below.

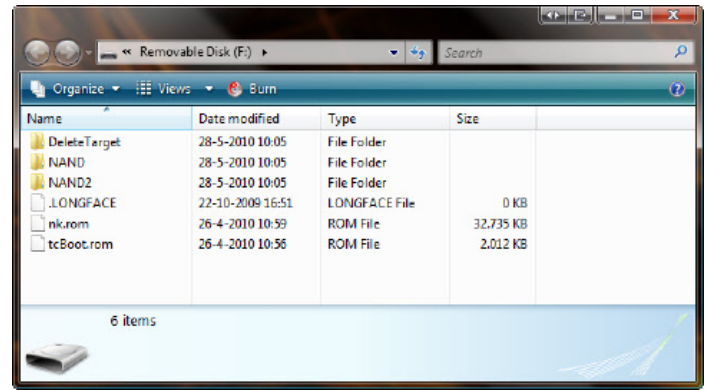
## Check the firmware version

Touch [  ] > [  ] > [Software].



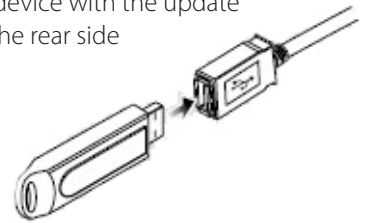
## Creating a USB memory device

1. Download the Updates from the Web site.
2. Decompress the downloaded file.
3. Copy the decompressed files to the "Root" of the USB memory device Like mentioned.



## Updating the program

1. Connect the USB memory device with the update to the USB connection on the rear side



2. The update will start automatically.



- It takes about 5 minutes to complete the update.

3. Wait until the update is completed.



4. Disconnect the USB memory device. The system will reboot automatically.

## Precautions

- Use a USB memory device to update your system.
- Update cannot be performed with other media (CD-R/RW, DVD-R/RW or SD media).
- Be sure to park the vehicle in a safe place before updating. Keep the engine running in order to prevent battery from running out.
- Do not turn off the engine or Navigation/Multimedia receiver power while updating. Update cannot be performed correctly and the Navigation/Multimedia receiver may become unusable.
